





Follow these simple steps:



1. Plan

Plan your menu and quantity of baked goods needed

Bake in advance for as far out as you need to!

1 quick baking session = weeks of product on-demand



2. Bake

Bake the Pillsbury™ Freezer-to-Oven Baked Goods when you have the time

 No skilled labor needed-Pillsbury[™] Freezer-to-Oven products are simple to use!



3. Freeze

Freeze the baked product for future use.

- Store frozen for up to 30 days!
- Allow product to cool completely before freezing
- TIPS:
 - i. Place on baking rack and cover with pan cover or freezer bag
 - ii. Individually wrap in plastic wrap to maximize shelf life and enable you to pull 1 unit at a time
- iii. Store like items together to prevent flavor transfer



4. When you're ready for fresh baked goods, remove product from freezer, **thaw and serve!**

- Options:
 - i. Thaw for 1 hour or covered overnight
 - ii. Microwave from frozen 30-45 seconds to thaw
- iii. Reheat freezer to oven-
 - Convection Oven at 300°F for 6-8 mins
 - Reel/Conventional Oven at 350°F for 10-12 mins
