How to Make a Seed Starter:

- 1** **SERVE** 2 oz. equivalent grain cereals
- 2** **HELP** students fill empty cereal cups with soil and seeds
- 3** **REMIND** students to water their plants every day, leave in sunlight
- 4** When seeds **SPROUT**, they're ready for the School Garden!
