- 1 Download scavenger hunt list item and, if need be, edit to fit your Summer Feeding Program area.
- 2 Print out several copies of the scavenger hunt item list and set them near your Nature Valley™ bars. Don't forget to set a rock on top if it's windy!
- 3 Students can divide themselves into small groups, assigning a team captain to grab a scavenger hunt list and Nature Valley™ bars to fuel their team!
- 4 Captains can decide on a time and a place to regroup with their items and share about what they found.
